### CIRCULAR 11 / 2019

#### 1) LEVEL 1-3 ARTISTIC PROVINCIAL ZONE FESTIVAL QUALIFIER

The KZNGU Zone Challenge qualifier takes places as follows:

- 📅 Date: Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> May 2019
- 📍 Venue: PMB Gymnastics Academy/ Mayors Walk/ PMB
- 📄 Entry Fee: R 300 per Gymnast Cat C R 200
- 📅 **Closing date: Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2019**  
(Even though it's elections & a public holiday)

#### Entries :

- 1) On line registration system only.
- 2) Please enter your coaches and judges online too.
- 3) Only registered gymnasts, coaches , judges can be entered on line
- 4) Gymnasts are required to enter and compete in at least one Interclub competition and qualify at a district event. All district results will be submitted to the office. Only gymnasts qualified with a 30.00 total in the respective District events will be permitted entry to the KZN Provincial Qualifier.
- 5) The event will open for entries on Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> April and close Tues 7<sup>th</sup> May
- 6) Only qualified coaches GL and higher may entered for this event will be permitted on the floor at the competition.
- 7) Please provide proof of payment in an email to KZNGU with 24 hours of concluding your online entry, indicate both the Club Name ( abbreviated) + ZFQ.  
Example: DBNNTH ZFQ

#### Medals and awards:

As per the directive of the SAGF MAG & WAG Program Management Committees, who have adjusted the Level 1 – 3 Programs to take into account the adopted Long Term Athlete development policy of the Federation, prize giving will take place under the following format. There will be no individual All around winners. Gymnasts will receive awards according to the scores they achieve.

- Qualification score for Zone Fest 30.00 and above
  - 35.20 or more - Gold
  - Between 34.00 and 35.15 - Silver
  - Below 33.95 - Bronze
  - NO APPARATUS AWARDS

## **Qualification for Selection to compete in the Central Zone Festival:**

### **WAG & MAG :**

Qualification score for selection to the Zone Festival event is a total score of **30.00** points

Age Groups for WAG & MAG as per the respective Manuals for WAG & MAG.

Please ensure gymnasts are correctly entered. Onus is on the clubs to determine the correct age and age group

### WAG

Level 1: 6 years, 7 years, 8 years, 9 years, 11 & under, 12 & over

Level 2: 6 years, 7 years, 8 years, 9 years, 11 & under, 12 & over

Level 3: 8 & under , 10 & under , 12 & under, 13 & over

### MAG

Level 1: 6-7, 8-9, 10-12

Level 2: 7-8, 9-10, 11-13

Level 3: 7-8, 9-10, 11-13

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE COMPETITION SERIES:**

All gymnasts, coaches and judges participating in this series are required to be registered SAGF members.

All coaches on the floor are required to be SAGF qualified. Minimum GL certification.

Coaches assisting in the event must be registered on line. Only these coaches will be permitted on the floor of the event.

All Judges must be registered on-line

## **ENTRY PROCEDURE:**

1. **PROVINCIAL COMP:** It is compulsory for all Gymnasts to qualify by entering
  - A minimum of 1 Club competition.
  - District qualifying event
2. Qualification to the Central Zone Fest : Gymnasts must achieve the required minimum 30.00 score at the Provincial competition.
3. Entries and Entry Fees for Provincial event via the SAGF online registration system only. Notification of payment via email, with correct reference. (Club name + CZ qualif)
4. **CENTRAL ZONE CHALLENGE.**



KZNGU will handle all entries for this event

- Parents are required to notify the KZNGU BY **Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2019** in the case of their child not accepting their place in the team.
- Team uniforms (tracksuits/ shirts / tog bags) may be ordered and purchased via their clubs only. Clubs will submit one bulk order with full payment to accompany the order. The KZNGU will not handle any individual orders
- Leotards must be ordered separately directly from the supplier as notified.
- Payment for the Zone Challenge event must be made by the parents to their clubs by the notified date. Please ensure you clearly notify your club of your payment

### PROVISION OF JUDGES: KZN PROVINCIAL QUALIFIER

1. Clubs are required to provide Judges for the Provincial competition.
2. Judges must be available for the full duration of the event.
3. It is up to the Clubs to ensure that their nominated judges have been informed and agree to be available for the entire event for which nominated.
4. It is also the responsibility of the Clubs to see that their nominated Judge/s are informed of the final program and judges rosters.
5. All judges are to be correctly attired in the official SAGF uniform as per the discipline rules.

#### 6. Procedure for Payment of Honoraria from:

##### JUDGES HONORARIA:

Judging assignments must be accurately recorded and confirmed / signed by the Director of Judging on the official KZNGU Claim Form which should be handed to the Comp Manager or Director of judging at the conclusion of the competition. Please ensure banking information is available.

A 'once off' honoraria payment will be made by electronic transfer to all judges at the conclusion of Level 1 – 3 / Novice Provincial KZNGU competition. Please ensure you have your bank details on hand. Bank, Account name & Number + Branch code is vital for once off payments – please assist in this regard.

### TECHNICAL REGULATIONS WAG & MAG

All technical rules and regulations as laid out in the respective WAG & MAG Levels Manuals and subsequent notifications will be applicable, for gymnasts, coaches & judges.

**Clubs are responsible for entering the gymnasts in the correct level and age-group.**

### REGULATIONS FOR COACHES / GYMNASTS / PARENTS

**CLUB LEADERS – PLEASE ENSURE YOUR COACHES / GYMNASTS / PARENTS ARE FAMILIAR WITH THESE REGULATIONS**

1. Coaches on duty are required to be dressed in club tracksuits with club shirts and sports shoes. No tights, jeans or casual clothing permitted.
2. Coaches are required to assist with the registration process, and the marshalling of the gymnasts between apparatus during the warm up and competition itself.



3. Coaches are prohibited from approaching the judges regarding the judging process and scores displayed, except where provision is made for D Score queries. SAGF Judges Code Protocol is to be followed.
  4. Apparatus may not be adjusted without the permission of the Competition Manager or the Apparatus assistants. Springboards and mats may not be removed from one apparatus to be used at another.
  5. Parents are not permitted in the grouping area or on the competition floor at any time during the competition. Competition area is off limits to all except gymnasts, coaches and judges and competition staff.
  6. Gymnasts are not permitted to have contact with their parents or other spectators during the competition and as such may not leave the competition area for any reason, other than to use the bathroom facilities (with the required permission) or to the First Aid station to receive any necessary attention.
- Contravention of any of the above can result in either penalties or disqualification for the gymnasts.

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### ***SELECTION CRITERIA & SELECTION PROCEDURES***

1. The Selection criteria to progress from 1 event to the other is advised above
2. The Technical representatives will review the results
3. Gymnasts selected to compete in the various stages of the events are required to comply with the uniform criteria:

<u>District &amp; Provincial Qualifier</u>	> Club uniforms
<u>Central Zone Festival</u>	> KZN Tracksuit with Union Badge Leotard (WAG) + Leovest & Shorts / Longs (MAG)
KZNGU Tog Bag	> Available from KZNGU Order via your club only
KZNGU Shirt	> Available from KZNGU Order via your club only
